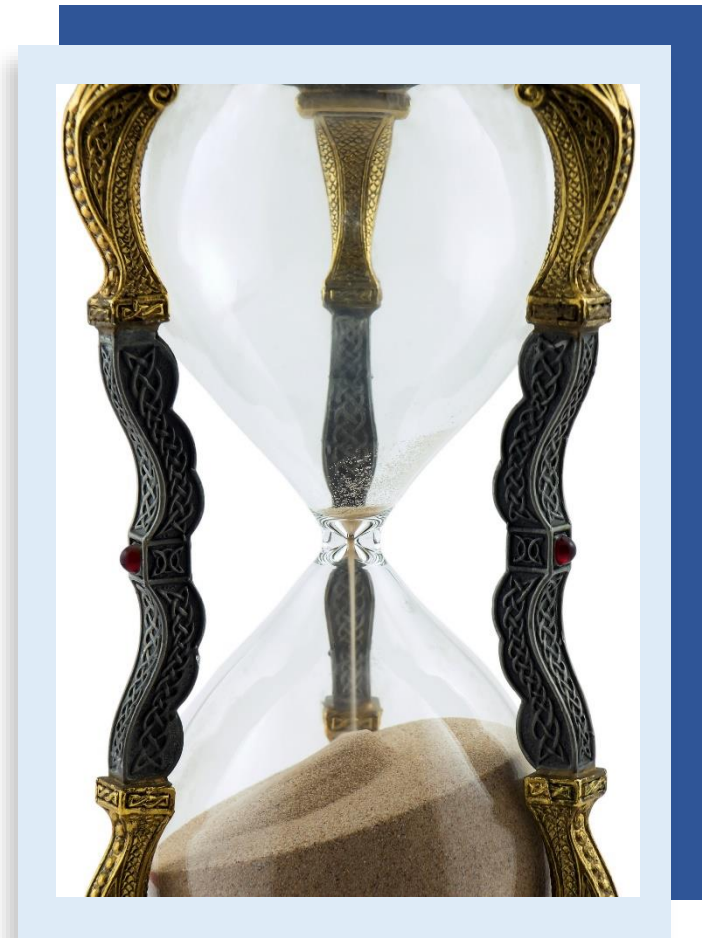

Martial Arts

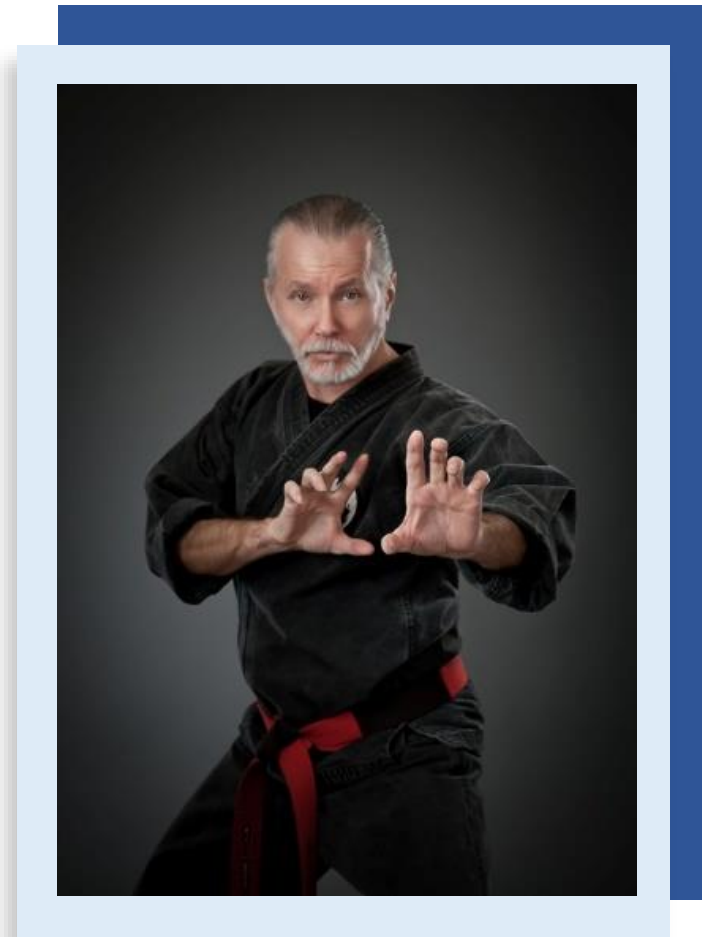
KIA: Mr. King is the founder, owner and chief instructor at the '**Karate Institute of America**' (est. 1979) in Orange County, California.

Kiado-Ryu: Mr. King developed **the Kiado-Ryu system of martial arts**, which incorporates an extensive curriculum of the following: Basic fundamentals, Forms (kata), Fighting (street & competitive), Weapons (bo, cane, nunchaku, sai, kubotan, knife), Self-defense technique, Extemporaneous combat.

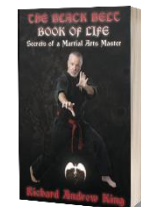
Black Belts: Mr. King produced **sixty-four (64) black belts** to date (average study time from beginner to Black Belt is six years). Mr. King's students have garnered over three-hundred championships, including Four National Championships.

Competitive History: Mr. King has personally won fifty-three (53) Championships at the Black Belt level, including 6 All Around Grand Championships of black belt champions in three different categories (weapons, forms and fighting). #1 rated weapons, fighting and forms competitor on a national level, 1989&1993, NASKA; 'Internationals' Forms Champion, 1990; Southern California Forms Champion, 1986.

Training: Mr. King began his martial art studies in the Spring of 1968 with the Tracy Brothers' Kenpo Karate organization in northern California, training with them for five years. Upon being transferred to southern California, he transferred to the Ed Parker Kenpo Karate system and received his first degree black belt from Bob Perry, a first generation Parker black belt. Thus, King is a 2nd generation Ed Parker black belt. In addition to being Grandmaster of his own Kiado-Ryu system, he also holds a 5th Degree Kenpo Black Belt rating.
