



## ‘You just don't get it’

You've heard this before, right? We all have. In fact, not only has this phrase been most likely directed toward us, but there's a good chance we've directed it toward others or at least thought of doing so. Akin to the phrase ‘You just don't get it,’ is its third person plural form, ‘They just don't get it.’ Does it mean that we all are universally ignorant? Or is there some other explanation to all of us ‘not getting it?’

Science is discovering that many species can see in ultraviolet. As humans, we cannot. Can you imagine all those creatures, who can, talking among themselves saying, ‘These humans just don't get it.’

We don't get it because we can't see it. And that's the exact point.

Saint Charan Singh, the Bible and Saint Kabir espouse a universal truth, a truth that our vision is extremely limited, extending from darkness to blindness – not a very wide range. In fact, and in consideration of the electromagnetic spectrum (EMS), our visual

acuity is no greater than 1% of everything existing in the physical universe. In other words, 99% of what exists in the physical realm according to the EMS is visually unknown to us, making us virtually blind! This is not even to mention the spiritual realms above and beyond this physical plane.

We're limited in our vision. In all truth, we only see what our personal numbers – the labels for our intrinsic energy frequencies – allow us to see. The reverse is equally true, we do not see what our numbers don't allow us to see.

Because of our numbers, those of our birth date and birth name, which combine to reveal the way we perceive the world, we're intrinsically short-sighted or ‘numerically myopic’ as the King's Numerology™ puts it.

Therefore, other people's viewpoints considered, we do ‘get it’ from our perspective even though we ‘don't get it’ from someone else's and vice-versa. We see things differently from other people and they see things differently from us.

## The Basic Matrix

A simple scan of only our Basic Matrix energies proves this myopia to us. Consisting of eight major components: Lifepath, Expression, PE, Soul, Material Soul, Nature, Material Nature and Voids, this simple numeric structure describes, in part, what we can and cannot perceive.

For example, let's take two people, one with a 4 Soul and the other with a 5 Soul. The Soul describes our most basic wants, needs and motivations. It is the energy that fuels our actions and drives us to success. Simply put, it's what we desire more than anything else.



## The 4 Soul

The 4 Soul wants, needs and is motivated by control, discipline, duty, guidelines, order, rules, safety, strength, structure and tradition. The 4 Soul seeks attachment, constancy, routine and stability of all kinds. The 4 Soul desires to create security and strong foundations, to serve and work. No Soul number is more diligent than the 4, nor more honest, loyal, persistent, practical, responsible and trustworthy. It is also determined, diligent, down-to-earth, methodical, reliable and steady!



## The 5 Soul

The 5 Soul wants no borders or boundaries, laws or rules. It abhors convention and loves to experiment. No Soul number is more adventurous, explorative and freedom-loving than the 5. Being ordinary and common is not in its DNA. The 5 Soul lives to be the rebel, the one who breaks the bonds of normality and pushes the limits of tradition. It needs to constantly be on the go, unbound by anything or anyone limiting its freedom. It also seeks constant stimulation and variety and gets extremely bored extremely fast.

In effect, 4 Soul and 5 Soul people see things totally differently. Their basic drives are completely opposite. When both of these people are confronted with the same idea, they will have totally different opinions about the issue at hand. A 4 Soul person will see things through his 4-colored lenses while a 5 Soul person will see things through his 5-colored lenses. Both of them will be correct from their own point of view and each could justifiably exclaim to the other, "You just don't get it," and they would both be right.

The same can be said for 1 versus 2 Soul people or 7 versus 8 Soul people. These number sets are also intrinsically opposite.

And the Soul is only one component, one layer, one veil of energy of the Basic Matrix, one part of the energy streams comprising our lives. Think of all the combinations of numbers, all the different layers or veils of energy each of us has to look through as we perceive life. It's really staggering when we think about it.

Furthermore, even if two people had the same single Soul number, say a 4, unless they shared the exact same root structure they, too, would see things differently.

For example, let's say the 4 Soul of one person contains a root structure of 31 [ $3 + 1 = 4$ ] and another 4 Soul person has a root structure of 58 [ $5 + 8 = 13 > 1 + 3 = 4$ ]. Even though their 4 crowns [single numbers] are the same, their roots of 31 and 58 are entirely different, and so each of these 4 Soul individuals will see things differently. They may be in the same 'color field', so to speak, but their 'hues' will be different. The 31-4 person will be motivated by artistic and self-expressive energies, perhaps graphic design, photography, sculpting, while the 58-13-4 person will be motivated by movement, sports, a varied calendar of social activities. Yet, they

are both 4s. These people share the same general energy. See the dilemma? Not only can crowns be different and cause people to see differently, the root structures of crowns also create variety, nuances and differentiations. Furthermore, all of this occurs simultaneously throughout the entire Basic Matrix, thus creating a numeric myopia from person to person.

## Life Cycle Patterns

The Basic Matrix is a good indicator of the complex way each of us sees life but it's not the only indicator. The Nine Life Cycle Patterns (LCPs) of the number 1 offer a compelling gauge as well. These nine LCPs are: 1/1, 1/2, 1/3, 1/4, 1/5, 1/6, 1/7, 1/8 and 1/9. They are determined by the Expression [name number] of the individual.

For example, in a 1/1 Life Cycle Pattern (LCP), the influencing energy of the 1 mixes with a 9 Expression person to create a 1 outcome. In a 1/2 LCP, the energy of the 1 mixes with a 1 energy person to create a 2 outcome. In a 1/3 LCP, the energy of the 1 mixes with a 2 Expression person to create a 3 outcome and so forth. In the LCP the Expression, therefore, becomes a filter or funnel for the influencing energy which becomes altered as it passes through the Expression, thus, creating an outcome.

What the LCPs reveal to us is the way in which each of us perceives a general energy specific to our own Expression. In the above grid, the LCPs are listed at the bottom. The 1 energy in the top row references the energy pertaining to the self, ego, identity, independence, initiative, leadership, and so forth. When this 1 energy, acting as the Incoming Influence, mixes with each of the nine Expressions, the Outcome is different for each Expression, each person. For example, a 1 Influencing energy mixing with a 1 Expression creates a 2 Outcome involving others, relationships, teamwork, and also potential conflict and deceit. However, when the 1 Influencing energy mixes with a 2 Expression person, the Outcome energy is 3, the vibration of art, beauty, children, communication, health, joy, self-expression, etc. And so it goes for each of the other seven Expressions.

This chart only addresses the 1 as the Influencing energy. We would follow the same process for the basic numbers 2 through 9, adding each of them as an influencing energy to each of the nine basic Expressions. This creates a total of 81 different number sets called I/R sets [Influence/Reality] within the nine Life Cycle Patterns.

Basically what this reveals is that each of us – because we are identified by a single number – only perceives 1/9<sup>th</sup> of what is occurring at any given time! The other 8 numbers have their individual perception as well. This LCP component contributes to our numeric myopia.

## Managing Numeric Myopia

So the question arises, ‘How do we manage our short-sightedness?’ Answer: by acknowledging that we are quite limited in our vision and that we can't perceive what others perceive or vice versa. Our personal perception is rooted in the numerical composition of our numerology charts which house a blueprint defining our perceptions. Thus, *we do not see things the way they are. We see things the way our numbers are.* It is virtually impossible to see things the way everyone else sees them or expect them to see things the way we see them. No two people see things exactly the same.

People with specific numbers in their charts will tend to agree with others who have similar numbers in their charts. People with contrasting numbers in their charts will tend to disagree with each other.

It is this knowledge of how each of us sees things through our own ‘numerical lenses’ that allows us, if we apply it, to achieve a greater understanding of issues between us and others and hopefully manage our differences in a more harmonious way, creating balance in our relationships. This is one of the great benefits of studying numerology and its application to life. If nothing else, it certainly will help us be more patient, tolerant and understanding when considering other points of view. It will also allow us to not expect other people to see things our way when it may be impossible for them to do so.

Hopefully, this new millennium, marked by the number 2 and representing the age of others and relationships, will bring this knowledge of numbers to the fore so people can understand one another more deeply and thereby improve their relationships and the quality of their lives. If an understanding of one another is not



accomplished, then the disparity between people will grow wider and deeper because the energy of the 2, which governs this millennium's duration through the year 2999, represents, in its negative aspect, competition, conflict and division. However, as all coins have two sides, the positive side of the 2 energy governs balance, cooperation, diplomacy, equalization, partnership and peace – the things most hope and pray for. Therefore, understanding that we each see life through our own 'numerical lenses,' it will be advantageous to everyone if we pause, consider not just what other people are saying but *why*, based on their numbers, they are saying what they are saying.

No one at this level of existence is perfect. That does not mean we should not work toward perfection, we should, but perfection exists in higher planes of existence. But for now, we're here and being here means we have a limited perception of life. We need to accept this fact and work with it, not against it. As we evolve spiritually, our perceptions will become greater, just like it does when we climb a mountain and look down below. The higher we go, the more we know because the more we see below. As we "climb" higher, our limited vision, our numeric myopia, will give way to greater vision. It's all a process. But while we're in the process, being aware that *we don't see things the way they are, we see things the way we are*, will help us stay more aware, balanced, centered, stable, and, hopefully, tender-hearted.
