AL CAPONE

~ GANGSTER ~

PUBLIC ENEMY NUMBER 1. That says all we need to know about AL CAPONE

Born *Alphonse Gabriel Capone* on 17 January 1899, “Big Al” as he was also called, was an American gangster and crime boss during the era of prohibition in the United States from 1920 to 1933. For those too young to remember, prohibition was a ban throughout America on alcohol including its sale, transportation, importation and production.

Prohibition was not popular. Bootlegging—the business of smuggling alcoholic drinks—became profitable for rival gangs. Organized crime was alive and well in Chicago.

Violence was rampant among competing gangs. Perhaps the most noteworthy event was the Saint Valentine’s Day Massacre on 14 February 1929 in which seven men of Capone’s rival North Side Gang were lined up against a wall and shot to death in broad daylight. Two shot guns and two Thompson submachine guns were used in the slaying. Although Capone was not present at the event, it was assumed he directed the killings. Outrage was huge, the government became involved, and from that time on Capone became known as “Public Enemy No. 1” and the most notorious mobster in America.

Once the feds got involved, Capone was found guilty of tax evasion and spent time in multiple prisons, among which was Alcatraz, i.e., “The Rock.” He was released from prison on 16 November 1939, spending his last days at his Palm Island mansion.

Scarface Al Capone was quite flamboyant. He dressed well, ate and drank well, enjoyed cigars and, although married, indulged in the companionship of unseemly women. This pastime was to be lethal for Capone who became infected with syphilis (neurosyphilis), an infection of the central nervous system which can damage the human skull. This led to other physical complications. Big Al Scarface died of cardiac arrest on 25 January 1947 at the age of 48.

Here we go again! Look at that Grand Umbrella: 9 Lifepath; 99-9 Expression and 9 PE. The 9 energy is commonplace in the chart of yet another well-known individual, whether that individual is manifesting positive or negative energy. Thus, the 9—as all numbers—is neutral regarding gender, color, race, political affiliation, country, etc. The key, as always, resides in how the 9’s energies are being used by the person who possesses them.

With a *Grand Umbrella*, which houses only 9s, an individual’s life will be totally consumed with the public in some way and it is impossible for it not to be. The reason is that both the Lifepath and the Expression serve as *filters* for other numbers in IR Sets. The Lifepath is the filter for letters and names. The Expression is the filter for all the other parts of the chart, such as the Life Matrix, Decade Timeline, 9th Cycle Timeline, Annual Cycle Patterns, etc. A few examples of other individuals with a Grand Umbrella are Good Guys Elvis Presley and Garth Brooks, and Bad Guys: Benedict Arnold and Lance Armstrong. These serve as excellent examples of the 9’s neutrality.

When the 99 occupies the Expression of a Grand Umbrella, it’s called the *Exp Grand Umbrella*. When the 99 occupies the PE, it’s called the *PE Grand Umbrella*. Therefore, Bad Guy Al Capone has an *Exp Grand Umbrella*.

Why the distinction between Exp and PE Grand Umbrellas? It’s because the Exp Grand Umbrella is the purest 99-9 component. It is derived solely from the individual’s natal name. However, the PE Grand

Umbrella is derived from a combination or combinations of the Life Path and its roots and the Expression and its roots and, hence, is not a pure 99-9.

Al Capone's 99-9 Exp Grand Umbrella indicates that Alphonse Gabriel Capone was a powerful, universally known, domineering individual. It's unfortunate he operated on the dark side of the 9 energy but he did, such was his karma. It is his 99-9 Exp Grand Umbrella that played a part in him being labeled as America's Public Enemy No. 1.

Capone's Soul and Material Soul are both 3s. The Material Soul also houses a 66 master root. This tells us that Capone's image was important to him, which it was. The 3 also governs pleasure, and Capone's history validates his pleasure-seeking lifestyle. The 3 also governs communication and no one dare argue with Scarface, a name he loathed, the result of being slashed three times on the left side of his face by the brother of a lady whom Big Al insulted. As a result of this "tri-slash," Capone had his photos show the right side of his face rather than the left side for obvious reasons. (Wikipedia)

The 66 master root in Capone's Material Soul corroborates his love (66) of image (3). The 66-3 is a highly sexual energy—a mirror sibling of the 33-6 which is also highly sexual. The 66-3 also reveals the importance of family, especially of one's "Crime Family." As we know, the Soul and Material Soul energies describe a person's most primal needs, wants, desires and motivations. To have the same number in one's Soul and Material Soul simply intensifies the energy. Thus, the 3 energy was quite germane to Capone's life.

Also of note are the two 6s in Big Al's Nature and Material Nature. His personality, therefore, was heavily focused on family.

(Note: It would be interesting to study the numbers of other "Crime Families" to ascertain the relationship between them and the 6. Families are families after all. Whether they're gangster families or regular families makes no difference to the 6, which is *the* number governing issues of family, love, nurturing, devotion, responsibility, etc.)

The 4 void in Capone's chart speaks to a lack of structure, security, foundation, work, service, organization and, in Capone's case, law and order. The only law and order Scarface supported was his own law and his own order. More on this later.

The 4 also governs discipline and self-control, a lack of which can generate problems. Perhaps Big Al should have considered his lack of discipline and self control when it came to carousing with a certain type of woman and the effects such interaction can generate.

Capone acquired syphilis as a result of his sexual activities, which were certainly related to his lack of discipline and self control. Syphilis was a major contributor to his death at age 48. Promiscuity definitely has its complications, and not thinking things through when it came to his sexual proclivities and ultimate consequences led Big Al to an early grave.

Al Capone’s Natal Basic Matrix is interesting and we can obviously learn a great deal about him and his personal profile from it, but what does his Common Basic Matrix reveal about him? Let’s take a look. It’s fascinating.

First, check out his voids: 2, 4, 8 and 9. This tells us the energy of his Common Name doesn’t care about or value others on a personal level (2v). Where have we seen this 2v before? How about Lance Armstrong, Jodi Arias, Ghislaine Maxwell, Richard Ramirez, Charles Manson, Jim Jones and now Al Capone. Arias, Ramirez, Manson, Jones and Capone were all killers. They didn’t care about the lives of people they killed. This leaves us asking, “How many killers have the 2v in their chart?” What’s the percentage? This would make a good and valuable study.

As the chart reveals, Capone's Common Name Matrix is saturated with the 2v in the master number 22, which could be ciphered as 2v2v-4v three times—one in the PE; one in the Soul and one in the Material Soul. With this 2v2v-4v triset, Al Capone had no feelings for the people he killed (2v2v) or the laws he broke (4v). In fact, it's as if he believed he was above the law. In many cases it was because he had developed relationships with some public officials who "looked the other way" when it involved Capone. Ultimately, however, the law finally caught up with Capone and imprisoned him, not for killing a whole host of people but for, of all things, tax evasion.

The 4v in this triset of the 2v2v-4v combination solidifies Capone's disrespect for law and order that we see in his Natal Basic Matrix. But look at his Expression. It's a 4v, too. Thus, four of the seven Basic Matrix components manifest a 4v. Capone was not interested in law and order. He mocked it. He was the law, he was the order, at least in Chicago. He bought his way through life until he finally got caught, for tax evasion no less!

The 9v Lifepath stays the same in his Common Name because it solely represents the day, month and year of birth. However, Capone's 9v Lifepath is strengthened by his 9v Nature and his 9v Material Nature. This creates an internal "stacking" of the voided 9's power.

To have only the number 9 and number 4 comprise the Basic Matrix is rare. What is even more rare is that the 9 and 4 are voided. In fact, his whole Basic Matrix is voided! Even more rare is that three of the four voided 4s are supported by the master number 22, which is also voided! And, of course, all these numbers and their voids belong to Public Enemy No.1—Al Capone, the most notorious mobster in American history.

What Al Capone's two Basic Matrices tell us is that their most unusual set of numbers and their voids, which are powerful, match Capone's life of crime. The numbers match the man. In this case, unfortunately, the man was a crook, mobster and murderer—not the kind of individual who should be regarded as an upstanding citizen and role model for others.

LIFE MATRIX

Al Capone's Life Matrix is as powerful as his Basic Matrices. In fact, his Life Matrix compounds and expands the capacity of his extensive power. As we see in the following Life Matrix (LM) chart, the most glaring number is the 99-9 which acts as a filter for all of the LM's eleven components. It sticks out like a sore thumb. You can't miss it.

What an incredible Life Matrix! Mostly, it's comprised of 1s, 8s, and 99-9s! The only other number is the 16-7 which manifests in the first Challenge as 16-7/(99-9)/16-7. Once again, we see a compression of a few numbers. Obviously, there's not much variety.

The 1s represent the self, ego, action and being the boss. The 9 is power. The 1/(99-9)/1 Influence/Reality Set occupies five of the LM's components and generates life linkage beginning with Capone's 2nd Epoch. Those five components of the 1/(99-9)/1 IR set are:

2nd Epoch, 2nd Pinnacle, Grand Pinnacle (3rd), Grand Challenge (3rd) and Crown Challenge (4th). These represent ego (1) and extreme power (99-9)—energy of a tyrannical mobster.

What is visually interesting is the vertical line of the 1/(99-9)/1 IR Set from the Grand Pinnacle to the bottom Crown Challenge. Plus, the Grand Pinnacle and Grand Challenge represent the core (the center) of a person's Lifepath. Capone's Lifepath is a 9, so his entire world was awash in ego and power, not just from the outside but from the inside. What we have to remember is that the Life Matrix is the interior structure of the Lifepath. Thus, the infrastructure of Capone's 9 Lifepath is a Life Matrix of massive 99-9 energy in which his ego is a major focal point.

It's also important to remember that the 99-9 (the middle number of each LM component) acts as a Filter for the first number on the left (the LIST), which strengthens the number on the right (the ROPE).

Take the 1/(99-9)/1 IR Set for example. The "1" on the left represents the Lessons, Influences, Subjects and Themes (LIST)—which in this case is the ego—passing through (filtering) the 99-9 and its power, thus affecting the number on the far right—the 1—which is the ROPE (Reality, Outcome, Performance, Experience); in this case also a 1 of ego. In short, when the 1 LIST of ego filters through the 99-9 of power, the outcome is a more powerful and dominant ego—the 1 ROPE. Therefore, the 1 ROPE energy will be more dominant than the 1 LIST energy. These five 1/(99-9)/1 IR Sets tell us that Al Capone was fueled largely by ego and power, which is perfectly reflective of his life.

The 44-8/(99-9)/8 Crown Pinnacle at the top of the Life Matrix represents management, engagement, orchestration, coordination. To get a better feel for what this means, visualize the Crown Pinnacle energies as drops of water or fire falling on the rest of the chart, i.e., the life. The other two 8/(99-9)/8 IR Sets are the 1st Epoch and 2nd Challenge.

The lone 16-7/(9)/16-7 in the 1st Challenge is the only other IR Set in Capone's Life Matrix. It represents a time period of 27 years of difficulty and trouble.

HOUSE OF LETTERS (SPECIFIC INCLUSION)

Another energy component enhancing all the power that exists in the Basic Matrices and Life Matrix of Al Capone is the master number 22 which sits within the First House of Letters.

The First House represents the ego, self and its identity. As the master builder number, the 22 strengthens and fortifies the 1 energy of self, as if strengthening Capone's ego and self-absorption needed more help.

The 22 in the First House means that in his full natal name, *Alphonse Gabriel Capone*, the letters "A" and "S" (letters marked by the number 1 of the alphabet) equal 22. His first name, "Alphonse," houses the letter "A" (1 point) and the letter "S" (19 points). When the "A" in "Gabriel" (1 point) and the "A" in "Capone" (1 point) are added to the mix, the result is a 22.

$$1 \text{ of A} + 19 \text{ of S} + 1 \text{ of A} + 1 \text{ of A} = 22.$$

NAME TIMELINES

Okay. I hope you're sitting down and not holding a cup of hot liquid that can be spilled.

The name "Alphonse" is a simple 9 in reduction. This reinforces every other 9 in the chart of Big Al Capone. When the 9 of "Alphonse" is added to his 9 Lifepath, the result is, of course, another 9. The Influence/Reality Set is then 9/(9)/9 which perfectly harmonizes with Capone's Grand Umbrella of 9-9-9.

The name "Gabriel" is also a 9 in reduction. Therefore, it's IR Set is a 9/(9)/9, too.

And you, perhaps, won't believe this but the name "Capone" is, guess what, a 9 in reduction—creating yet another 9/(9)/9 to match, not only his first two names, but also his Grand Umbrella. What are the odds of this happening—his three names at birth all manifesting a 9 energy and those three 9s resonating perfectly with his 9-9-9 Grand Umbrella, as well as the other 9s in his chart, such as his Common Name Basic Matrix? It's almost unbelievable.

SUMMARY

The chart of Al Capone is one of the most stunning, dazzling and impressive charts in the annals and archives of the King's Numerology™. It is incredible how all of the parts and components of Capone's chart harmonize perfectly with each other. How sad it is that such power was spent in such nefarious ways as being a criminal, gangster and killer. One can only ponder how much good Alphonse Gabriel Capone could have done in this world if he were to point his energies in divine directions. "If" could never be bigger!"

And what about the 4v in his Natal Name as well as the 2, 3, 8 and 9 voids in his Common Name? They each played a major role in how all of the energies in his chart worked together to create his life and experiences.

Capone's chart is a must study for students of numerology. It is unique, informative and highly unusual. Of all the charts of the Bad Guys in this 13th Volume of the King's Book of Numerology™ series, Al Capone's chart is the most interesting and unique. It is a rich cornucopia of knowledge of how the 1 and 9 energies reflect ego, power and dominance.
